**DR. JACQUELINE COGDELL DJEDJE IS PROFESSOR, FORMER CHAIR OF ETHNOMUSICOLOGY,
AND FORMER DIRECTOR OF THE ETHNOMUSICOLOGY ARCHIVE AT UCLA. HER RESEARCH
FOCUSES ON AFRICAN AND AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSIC, WITH SPECIALIZATIONS ON FIDDLING
AND BLACK MUSIC IN CALIFORNIA.**

1970s. SPECIAL ATTENTION WILL BE GIVEN TO CHURCHES THAT BECAME WELL KNOWN CENTERS FOR GOSPEL, MUSICIANS
WHO VISITED THE CITY, ARTISTS WHO CAME FROM ELSEWHERE AND SETTLED IN LOS ANGELES AND NATIVES OF LOS ANGELES
WHO BECAME ESTABLISHED GOSPEL ARTISTS.**
